LIFEgroup Discussion Questions

Delight fully in Jesus

April 15, 2018

Text: John 9.1-41

This week, let's have an extended time of prayer in our life groups for all our friends that have recently heard the gospel. Let's ask God to open their eyes. To make them realize their blindness. To have mercy on them.

For the Bible study part, the main idea of John 9 is that Jesus can give us sight if we recognize our blindness. However, we can also be encouraged by the simple and powerful example of the man born blind. There are at least four lessons to be learned from his example:

1. He focuses on the person and words of Jesus.
2. He knows how to say "I don't know" when he does not know something. This is very important to notice (and quite encouraging too!) Because many Christians have the false impression that to witness to a friend is to win debates.
3. Throughout the chapter, we see that he progresses both in knowledge of who Jesus is and encouraged to proclaim these truths. (This is very important to notice to balance out the previous point and laziness)
4. He hangs on to the few rock-solid certainties of what Jesus has done in his life.

This week consider which of these four areas are you best? In which do you most need to progress? For every characteristic of this man's testimony let's examine ourselves and see where we most need to progress.
