The Hope and Joy of the Resurrection

Read: Acts 2.22-33

1. Before Peter began to speak what occurred on this day of Pentecost? Who is the audience that Peter is speaking to? Why are they in Jerusalem?
2. Where do we get this idea of God's endorsing of Jesus in this text (2.22)? What are the five endorsements of God for Jesus?
3. Who does Peter put the blame of Jesus' death on? Besides man's responsibility what do we see about the death of Jesus in this text?
4. What is the contrast that Peter brings about from 2.23 to 2.24?
5. What are the two testimonies that we have in this text? How does Peter use David's testimony? What do we learn from David's heartfelt words with what Peter shares to speak of Christ? What is the significance of Peter using David's words? Discuss.
6. Do we love the presence of God like David did? God is everything to Him. So, we must ask, do we have such satisfaction in God? Is He truly enough? What makes us struggle with such satisfaction in the Lord?
