## ***LIFEgroup Discussion Questions***

**Text:** Acts 9.1-19

1. Who was Saul (Philippians 3.5-6)? Why was Saul so set on exterminating Christians and seeing Christianity as a rebellion (9.1-2)?
2. Discuss what happens on the road to Damascus (9.3-9). What do we see as fruit in Saul's life immediately following his encounter with Jesus?
3. Look at the text and think for a minute what does Jesus do in this episode? List out everything you see Him doing.
4. What might Saul's blindness represent? Could you imagine what the rest of the journey from the point of the encounter with Jesus to Damascus might have been like? Discuss.
5. What do we learn from Ananias? He has some reservations (no doubt anyone would), but what does he model for us?
6. Read 1 Timothy 1.15-16. How does Saul's conversion speak to us the church?
