Sacred Psalms: My One and Only Hope

June 25, 2017

Read: Psalm 27

1. As David begins this psalm what does He remember about God and reflect on (27.1-2)? What do we see about David's hope and confidence as a result? What can we learn from David in 27.1-3 when it comes to what we face daily and as we walk through challenges?
2. What is the foundation and motivating force to David's hope and confidence (27.4)? David's single desire is to know and love the Lord more and more each day. As you think of life and its stages what competes against having this single focus like David has?
3. David longed for more and more of God's presence. How can we like David draw nearer to God each day implied in His statement, *to behold the beauty of the Lord and to meditate in His temple*? What does David mean when he says, *to meditate*? What did the presence of God mean to David in the face of trouble?
4. How do we see David putting into practice what His heart desires in 27.7-10? How do we see David's hope in God in His prayer? What kind of spirit do we see in David as He prays? What does prayer ultimately do for us?
5. How does David's final statement of hope encourage you (27.13-14)?
