Sacred Psalms – Two Persons, Two Ways, Two Destinies

July 6, 2014

Read: Psalm 1

1. What are the two different types of persons in the world? What does it mean to be righteous? How is the righteous described as being (1.1)?
2. What does the righteous not do? What is the progression that is seen in 1.1 with the relationship of the righteous with the wicked? Discuss what it means to walk in the counsel of the wicked, to stand in the path of sinners and sit in the seat of scoffer.
3. What is the stark difference between the wicked and the righteous (1.2)? What does it mean to delight in the law of the Lord and to meditate in His law day and night? What is your regular intake of the Word look like? What is our approach to the Word and how such an impact by the Word happen in our lives?
4. Think about the meaning of the tree firmly planted by streams of water. How does that tree compare to the righteous? What is important to come from a disciple of Jesus Christ?
5. What is the final destiny of the righteous and wicked? What does it mean that God knows the way of the righteous?
