### ***Sacred Psalms: His Greatness and Grace***

***July 16, 2017***

#### **Read: Psalm 81**

1. Psalm 81 and 11 other psalms are credited to Asaph. Who was Asaph? (READ: 1\_Chronicles 6:31-32, 39 / 1 Chronicles 16:5 / 2 Chronicles 29:30 / 2 Chronicles 5:12-13 / 1 Chronicles 25:1 / Ezra 2:41)
2. The two primary purposes of a church worship service are expressed in this psalm. The first can be found in verses 1 to 7 and the second in verses 8 to 16. Summarize these two purposes in as few words as possible.
3. Find the two exclamation points in Psalm 81. Who is speaking and what is he yelling about?
4. Describe a time as a parent (or from your childhood with your parent) when your child would have been saved from pain or grief if he/she would have only listened to you.
5. In verse 10 God says, "Open your mouth wide and I will fill it." Think of baby birds in a nest. Can we ever over expect God? Will God fill a closed mouth?
6. Charles Spurgeon said, "Our cup is small and we blame the fountain." Have you asked God for anything big lately?
