LIFEgroup Discussion Questions

Our God Reigns

August 13, 2017

Text: Psalm 96

1. The theme of this Psalm is found in verse 10: Say among the nations, “The LORD reigns; indeed, the world is firmly established, it will not be moved; He will judge the peoples with equity.”
Psalm 96:10 When do you struggle with the idea that God really reigns? When have you seen evidence of the reign in your life?
2. What does it mean to sing a new song to the Lord (vs.1-2)? What new song are you singing?
3. How can we tell of the glory of God (vs.3-6)? What are some gods that we worship but are powerless to create the universe?
4. Look up the word “ascribe” and agree on a meaning. Talk about how we can ascribe to the Lord to the Lord (vs.7-8)
5. Worshipping in holy attire (v. 9) is not just talking about clothing. Worship is first and always about our heart. How are we to “dress” our heart?
6. Can each person truly say “The Lord reigns” (v.10) in their heart? Seek to be honest and talk about areas of confession and areas of recommitment.
7. If possible read verses 11-13 together in unison and/or make it your closing prayer.
