Sacred Psalms: God-fearers Seek Peace

Read: Psalm 34.11-14

1. According to the Psalm and sermon today, what is foundational to being one who seeks and promotes peace? What does it mean to fear God? What does the bible say about those who do not have a relationship with God (James 4.4)? What has God done to make us no longer enemies, but now at peace with Him and truly His friends (Colossians 1.19-20)? What brings us this peace (Romans 5.1; Galatians 3.26)?
2. So, now that we are at peace with God, what quality is manifested in us that was not there before (Galatians 5.22)? We also can experience this peace from God on a daily basis. What does the Apostle Paul say about this experience Philippians 4.6-7?
3. What does the bible say about pursuing peace with others – Hebrews 12.14? What is a disagreement? How do we handle disagreements (Romans 14.1)? When does conflict arise? What are some reasons for conflict occurring? What is the source of conflict according to James (James 4.1-2)?
4. What does Paul say we are to put away (Ephesians 4.31) and are to put on (4.32)? What does Jesus say about ungodly anger and hate (Matthew 5.21-22)? How are we to respond even to unbelievers according to Romans 12.17-21?
5. What does the bible say about how we should handle a situation where a brother or sister has sinned against us (Matthew 18.15-17)? Should it ever be played out or handled on Facebook or through email?
6. Read Proverbs 19.11. How can this proverb be of great help when dealing with others?
