## **LIFEgroup Discussion Questions**

### **Go: Everybody on Mission**

**October 5, 2014**

**Read:** 1 Peter 2.9-10

1. Discuss the mission of God. How would you summarize it? Use the following themes to help you: *God's Design; Sin and Brokenness, Gospel, Repent and Believe and Recovered and Purpose.*
2. Read John 17.18. When we think about living a life of mission, how does this verse speak to that? How has the Father sent Jesus into the world? What was His mission? So, what does it mean that as the Father has done so with Jesus, that Jesus has done just the same with us? Do we see, think about or live our everyday lives as though we have been *sent*?
3. What drives the mission of God in our everyday lives? Go back to 1 Peter 2.9-10 to answer this.
4. Who are we according to 1 Peter 2.9? What does it mean that we are *a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, and a people for God's own possession*? Think, why does our identity matter to when it comes to us living for the mission of God daily?
5. As Christians, what are we to do according to 1 Peter 2.9-10? What is our purpose? What does it mean to proclaim the excellences of Christ? What are we to specifically tell people according to Peter?
6. How does understanding and embracing our identity and purpose everyday impact the way we live? Think about it as a group in the following areas:  
*In our job?*  
*As a stay-at-home mom?*  
*In relation to our neighbors?*  
*With the sports team that our kiddos play on?*  
*The campus I am on for my education?*  
*Other...?*
