Advent – Fixed on Jesus: *None Greater*

November 27, 2016

Text: Hebrews 1.1-2.4

1. What was the context of the letter of Hebrews as far as what the church was dealing with and the kind of pressures they were facing (Hebrews 10.34; 13.3)? What were some in the church struggling with when it came to trust and worship (Hebrews 1.4, 14)?
2. What does the writer do to fix our attention to what is most important? Who does He fix on (1.2-13)? How has God spoken through time, including the Old Testament and now how has He as His final revelation (1.1-2)?
3. What are the seven works of God or facts about Jesus in 1.2-3 that the writer speaks of to support that Jesus is superior to all and that there is none greater?
4. Angels are created heavenly beings that were being overemphasized by some in the church, putting them in a place worthy of God that was meant for Jesus. What are some things that we do that to?
5. What does the writer do next to again give evidence of the superiority of Jesus, especially to angels (1.4-14)? With these seven scripture quotations from the Old Testament what is the main point the writer is making (answer: Jesus is the everlasting King of all and angels are sent ministers/servants).
6. What does the writer call us to in response to the greatness of Jesus (2.1-4)? How might we pay much closer attention to Jesus this advent season and not neglect Him or the gospel?
