3. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love (Rom. 12:10)
4. Be kind to one another, tender-hearted (Eph. 4:32)
5. Be of the same mind toward one another (How?)
Do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation (Rom. 12:16, 15:5)
6. Be subject to one another in the fear of Christ (Eph 5:21)
7. Bear one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2)
8. Bearing with one another (Col. 3:13)
9. Build up one another (I Thes. 5:11)
10. Clothe yourselves with humility toward one another (1 Pet 5:5)
11. Comfort one another (1 Thess. 4:18) (2 Cor. 1: 4,6,7)
12. Confess your sins to one another (James 5:16)
13. Edify one another (1 Thess. 5:11; Rom. 14:19)
14. Encourage one another (Heb. 3:13; 10:25)
15. Fellowship with one another (1 John 1:7)
16. Forgive one another (Eph. 4:32; Col 3:13; 2 Cor. 2:6-8)
17. Give preference to one another in honor (Rom. 12:10)
18. Greet ... with a holy kiss (1 Cor. 16:20; 2 Cor. 13:12; 1 Thess. 5:26; 1 Pet 5:14; Rom. 16:16)
19. Have the same care for one another...(no partiality - 1 Cor. 12:25)
20. Live in peace with one another (1 Thess. 5:13; 2 Cor. 13:11)
21. Love one another (Rom. 13:8; 1 Thess. 3:12, 4:9; 1 Pet 1:22; 1 John 3:11, 23; 4:7,11)
(1 Pet. 4:8) (1 Pet. 1:22 says love “from the heart”)
22. Pray for one another (James 5:16)
23. Regard one another as more important than yourself (Phil. 2:3,4)
24. Seek after what is good for one another (1 Thess. 5:15)
25. Serve one another (Gal. 5:13; 1 Pet. 4:10)
26. Show hospitality toward one another without complaint (1 Pet. 4:9)
27. Showing forbearance to one another (Eph. 4:2)
28. Speak truth each one of you with his neighbor for we are members on one another
(Eph. 4:25; Eph. 4:15) Do not lie to one another (Col. 3:9)
29. Speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16)
30. Stimulate one another to love and good deeds (Heb. 20:24)
31. Submit to one another (Eph. 5:21)
32. Teach one another (Col. 3:16)
33. When you come together to eat, wait for one another (1 Cor. 11:33)
34. Wash one another's feet (John 13:14)

“NEGATIVE ONE ANOTHER” COMMANDS

1. Do not bite and devour one another, lest you be consumed by one another (Gal. 5:15)
2. Do not complain brethren, against one another, that you yourselves may not be judged (James 5:9)
3. Do not lie to one another (Col. 3:9)
4. Do not speak against one another .. who are you to judge your neighbor? (James 4:11)
5. Learn not to exceed what is written, in order that no one of you might become arrogant in behalf of one against the other (legalism) (1 Cor. 4:6)
6. Let us not become boastful, challenging one another (superiority), envying one another (inferiority) (Gal. 5:26)
7. Let us not judge one another any more, but rather determine this; not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way (license) (Rom. 14:13)
8. Stop depriving one another (1 Cor 7:5)
