

Common Definition

Disciple- A follower of Jesus resulting in a transformation of head, heart, and hands.

"And He said to them, I will make you fishers of men" Matthew 4:19

- Head- We follow Jesus in belief and surrender
- Heart- We follow Jesus by learning foundational truths and taking on key habits of the Christian life resulting in God transforming us from the inside out.
- Hands- We follow Jesus by taking on His mission with our hands

Disciplemaking- An intentional and relational process by which we engage people with the Gospel of Jesus unto belief and equip the Body of Christ for Kingdom work.

Disciplemaker- A disciple of Jesus who is committed to multiplying other disciplemakers from salvation to maturity.

Missional- An intentional and strategic effort to engage the world with the Gospel of Jesus in word and deed.

Gospel Saturation- When every man, woman, and child have an encounter in word and in deed with Jesus Christ every day.

Transformation Group- A group of people in all stages on the journey of faith, living in authentic relationships, learning from one another, living on mission, and taking steps of obedience in being a disciple of Jesus.

Transformation Group Leader- A disciplemaker committed to being a servant-leader to members of our local congregation in their journey of following Jesus.

Huddle- a group of 2-3 committed to meeting on a consistent basis to pursue Jesus through study, accountability, and action resulting in a transformed life. (*personal discipleship*)
