**Genesis 3.1-13**  
**April 15, 2018**

What are some of the messages (explicit or subtle) that you got growing up as you observed how your parents and others in your community used or viewed their money?

“Money doesn’t buy happiness.” What’s your reaction to this statement? How does your behavior answer this question?

What discrepancy is there between what God told Adam (Gen 2.16-17) and how Eve describes what God said (Gen 3.3)? Why do you think Eve added a restriction to what God told Adam? Why is this significant?

When do you find yourself doubting God’s care for you, or believing that he is holding back the good stuff? Any patterns?

The serpent made a false promise to Eve that if she ate the fruit, she would get to be like God. What false promises are we given in regards to wealth?

In what ways do you attempt to cover yourself, or make yourself more presentable, with money?

How does the gospel begin to free us from the magic spell that money can cast over us?

How might we help one another see more clearly and trust more fully God’s generous care for us? Any concrete ideas?
