What are some things you were taught growing up about the end times (or the “far future” of humanity)? What sort of impact did this have on you?

If a forest fire forced you to flee your house in minutes, what are a few things you would grab?

Why is it so easy for us to miss the signs of Christ’s presence in our lives and the lives of those around us?

How might we grow in awareness of Jesus’ presence and activity in our lives? How can others help? Consider spending time together helping each other to really see even little ways Jesus is graciously present in one another’s lives.

How does our impatience with God’s pace of change and renewal make us vulnerable to “snake oil salesmen”? Examples?

Share some examples of FOMO (fear of missing out) in your life. How does the reality of God’s kingdom being present among us address FOMO in your life?

How might the contours of your life look different if you held more loosely to things of earth and lived with more of an eternal perspective? Dream together about how to engage in mundane activities with an eye to the kingdom of God.
