Revelation 5

What is the most regal or formal ceremony you have ever observed or experienced?
Why did the participants or the circumstances deserve such a dignified service?
What was your role in the activity (participant – if so, doing what? Observer?)

How have you recently experienced the brokenness of this world?
How has this experience, if at all, impacted your expectation for Jesus' return to establish a perfect new heaven and earth?

Jesus turned the tables on the world's idea of leadership and royalty. He told the disciples that his leaders must be servants (Mark 10:43-45) and as Messiah he would be a suffering servant (Isaiah 53:3-12; Philippians 2:6-11). How is this different from the ideas of leadership and authoritative positions that you have seen or experienced?

How do you see your calling to exhibit Christ's style of leadership in your home?
Neighborhood? Workplace?
