



Our vision for the Junior High Class is that The Oaks Kids would enjoy a structured environment where they can hear & explore God's Word and build community through learning about God together. We realize this vision through reading God's Word, praying together, and memorizing scripture and a catechism. This class is unique in that we encourage this age group to sit with their families during worship, come to class during the sermon, and then return to the sanctuary after the sermon – sitting together as a class in their reserved row until a parent picks them up after the service. Kids may also sit with their class before the sermon if you prefer.

Our Junior High Class studies the Northstar Catechism, learning 1-2 per week. We recommend having the [catechism](#) accessible in your home. Other great resources to use at home are The Oaks Kids take home sheet/email, which explains the main truth of our lesson each week and provides parents with discussion questions.

While we really value our time with the kids on Sunday, our primary goal is to equip you as parents – the primary disciple-makers – to share Jesus with your kids during your days. You're not in this alone – we're here to help and to explore how to do this together.
