Conversation Starters #1: Questions for God in Prayer

Sometimes when you pray, it's hard to get started. One way to begin is to ask God a question. We suggest that you pick one question from the list below, and use it as a conversation starter. Avoid the temptation to run the questions below as a prayer list. Just pick one question, and then *listen*.

When you slow down in prayer and ask God a question, you are inviting Him to lead your prayer time. There's a lot He wants to say. We've found that some of the deepest moments of revelation, healing, and repentance come from prayer that begins with a question to God. These questions require Him to actually answer you. Wait for his answer.

Ask the Lord questions like these:

- What is on your mind?
- Who is on your heart?
- What do you want to say to me?
- What do you want me to do, today?
- What should I pray?
- How can I bless you?
- Who do you want me to bless? How?
- How do you feel about me?
- What Scriptures would you teach me, today?
- Search my heart; what wickedness is in me?
- What costly thing can I do for your Kingdom today?
- Where have I been wrong?
- What would help me to enjoy you more?
