Lunch with the Girls began the study of Living God's Will. Each week we hope to share some wisdom. Here are some important ideas from this past week's lesson on **Discerning God's Will: Discerning the Will of God is not possible unless you know Him and have a relationship with Him....**a relationship developed through prayer, study of the Word, faith, waiting, surrender, walking daily, It's important to realize and trust that God does have plan for you and, not only that, but God actually **wants** us to know His Will more than we do. **We need to know God's Will so that we "may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way."** (Col 1⁹⁻¹⁰) Not every decision is a yes or no decision as much as an acceptance of **"Thy Will be done"** and also an awareness that we need God's wisdom..."The LORD gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding" (Prov 6²) **In summary:** Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering..... Readily recognize what He wants from you, and quickly respond to it. ... God brings the best out of you.... Romans 12:1-2
