

Volunteers needed for the Quarterly All-Church Potluck/Members' Meeting 4/22/18:

1. Setter-Uppers – 10 men to report to the Gym at 12:15pm on Sunday, April 22nd, right after the Worship Service, to: make sure bleachers are pushed in and push bleachers back in if they are out; set up eating tables and serving tables; set up chairs at eating tables; cover eating tables with plastic and tape; cover serving tables with tablecloths provided; set up children's crayon tables and tape (make sure to get crayons and paper, if needed).
2. Tearer-Downers – 10 men to remove plastic table coverings and trash, fold up tablecloths and put in blue plastic bin, fold up tables and chairs and put them away,
3. Cleaner-Uppers – 8 people to clean the gym after the Members' Meeting is finished, inc. sweep floor, take out trash, walk through the Worship Center after the Meeting to collect trash, scoop up and Lost & Found items, and leave both the Gym and the Worship Center cleaner than they were before the Meeting began.
4. Sanitation Engineers – 4 high schoolers to change the trash cans as needed during the Potluck, replacing full bags with new trash liners
5. Sanitation Drivers – 3 high schoolers (previously qualified) to drive the electric vehicle to take the trash to the trash bin
6. Master Clickers – 4 amateur (but good) photographers to take candid photos of everyone at the Potluck. Before Monday morning, April 23rd, email those candid photos to john.kooker@gmail.com
7. Door Greeters – 3 women to work the Nametag Table from 4:30-5:15pm in the Gym as people arrive for the Potluck
8. Potluck Greeters – 4 women to help members place food on the Serving Tables. Ensure that there is a serving utensil in each item, as needed. Ensure that it is cut, and ready to serve, as needed.
9. Usher/Usherettes – 4 child/parent teams to hand out Programs as members enter the Worship Center after the Potluck. Children will be handing out the Programs, under the guidance and tutelage of their parent, as needed.
10. Program Folders – 2 people to report to the Church Office on Thursday, April 19th, to fold the Program Handouts.
11. Crayon Table Monitors – 3 children (4th grade and up) or adults to monitor the Children's Drawing Tables to ensure that all crayons stay at the table and that all children who participate enjoy a wonderful time.
