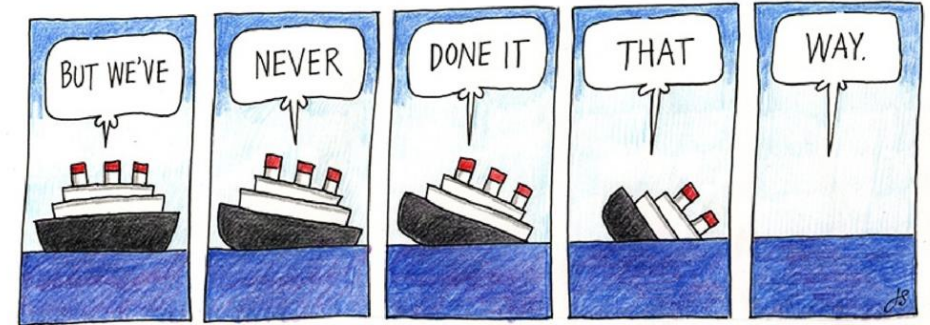

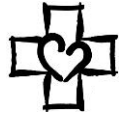

Volunteer Needed to fill candles for the altar and advent wreath for the months of Oct, Nov, & Dec. Contact the office to help!

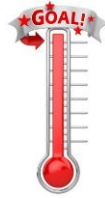
Trinity After School For Kids - Volunteers are needed to help with our TASK Program after school. Contact Shannon Struecker at 341-3117 for more information.
