

PASTOR: Lord, we come confessing that when we were slaves to sin, we let sin reign in our mortal bodies, to make them obey their various passions.

ALL: **But the fruit we were getting at that time was from things of which we are now ashamed.**

PASTOR: The end of those things is death. But now we have been set free from sin and become your slaves.

ALL: **And the fruit we now get leads to sanctification and abundant life.**

PASTOR: Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.
