THE RYM YLT with Pastor Joe Novenson:

I was recently able to attend part of the Youth Leader Training put on by Reformed Youth Ministries. I wanted to share the following with you:

*Matthew 18 teaches that the heart kept (Prov. 4:23) is actually described by Jesus as keeping other spiritual children from stumbling. And the keeping of that heart is not done by doing the least wrong, the most right, for the longest amount of time, under the greatest number of conditions. That is greatness everywhere else. But, in this Kingdom, spiritual greatness is knowing gospel **humility**, gospel **hospitality**, gospel **hopefulness**, gospel **honesty**, gospel **severity with sin**. In summary: It is **not** never doing something wrong, it is knowing what to do that is holy after you have done something wrong; it is being the biggest, deepest, fastest repenter anyone has ever seen.¹*

Those are some incredible thoughts to ponder as we consider what it means to shape the lives of our students. Lead them to repentance; model it for them.
