

*Prayer of Adoration

PASTOR: Let us pray that we may walk in the risen life of Christ in glory:

ALL: Lord of life and power, who through the mighty resurrection of your

Son overcame the old order of sin and death to make all things new in him: Grant that we, being dead to sin and alive to you in Jesus Christ, may reign with him in glory; to whom with you and the Holy Spirit be praise and honor, glory and might, now and for all eternity. Amen.

Proclamations of the Resurrection

PASTOR: Let us now proclaim the reality of the resurrection:

PEOPLE: He who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and

bring us into his presence.

Worship Team: Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death,

and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

PASTOR: How can we who died to sin still live in it? Do we not know that all

of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his

PEOPLE: We were buried therefore with him through baptism into death,

in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory

of the Father, we too might walk in the newness of life.

Worship Team: Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death,

and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

Pastor: If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been

raised from the dead. And if Christ has not been raised, then our

preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain.

But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits PEOPLE:

> of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all

die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive!

Worship Team:

Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death,

and upon those in the tombs bestowing life!

PASTOR: There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus!

(Romans 8.1)

PEOPLE: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, new creation. The old has

passed away; behold, the new has come.

ALL: Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by death,

and upon those in the tombs bestowing life! (3X)
