Christ, the humble and exalted one. [WSC Q. 27, 28]

27. How was Christ humiliated?

Christ was humiliated: by being born as a man and born into a poor family;¹ by being made subject to the law² and suffering the miseries of this life,³ the anger of God,⁴ and the curse of death on the cross;⁵ and by being buried⁶ and remaining under the power of death for a time.⁷

¹ **Luke 2:7** And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.

2 Corinthians 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.

² **Galatians 4:4** But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,

³ **Isaiah 53:3** He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces

he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

Luke 9:58 And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head."

John 4:6 Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour.

John 11:35 Jesus wept.

Hebrews 2:18 For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

Hebrews 12:2-3 looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

⁴ **Psalms 22:1** My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning?

Isaiah 53:10 Yet it was the will of the Lord to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the Lord shall prosper in his hand.

Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Luke 22:44 And being in agony he prayed more earnestly; and his sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

1 John 2:2 He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

⁵ **Galatians 3:13** Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"—

Philippians 2:8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

⁶ **1 Corinthians 15:3-4** For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

⁷ **Matthew 12:40** For just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

28. How is Christ exalted?

Christ is exalted by His rising from the dead on the third day,¹ His going up into heaven,² His sitting at the right hand of God the Father,³ and His coming to judge the world at the last day.⁴

¹ **1 Corinthians 15:4.** that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,

² **Psalm 68:18** You ascended on high,
leading a host of captives in your train
and receiving gifts among men,
even among the rebellious, that the LORD God may dwell there.

Mark 16:19 So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven and sat down at the right hand of God.

Acts 1:11 and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."

Ephesians 4:8 Therefore it says,
"When he ascended on high he led a host of captives, and he gave gifts to men."

³ **Psalm 110:1** The Lord says to my Lord: "Sit at my right hand
until I make your enemies your footstool."

Acts 2:33-34 Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing. 34 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says,
"The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand,

Ephesians 1:20 that he worked in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places,

Hebrews 1:3 He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

⁴ **Matthew 16:27** For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the glory of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.

Acts 1:11 and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven."

Acts 17:31 because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead."
