Imagine the most wonderful blessing you could ever receive, and then multiply it exponentially! That's what God wants to do for you, and in you, through you.

As you know, we at Trinity have decided to enter into a partnership with The Lutheran Church Extension Fund in order to conduct a capital campaign.

As our congregation moves into its capital campaign, called *For Generations to Come*, we're following a process based on Ephesians 3:20-21 — "Now to Him Who is able to do immeasurably more than we can ask or imagine...." The campaign will have three distinct phases – Imagine, Inform, Inspire – and will then launch into Immeasurably More, as we begin to experience all that God desires for us.

The first phase of our *Immeasurably More* process is called **Imagine**. We're invited to envision what God wants to do in us and through us, as a congregation and as individuals. We'll talk about ministry, and all that has been prepared for us as we, the people of God, love and serve the people in our community.

Imagine is the "why" and "how" phase of the campaign. We will articulate exactly why we are undertaking this campaign, and how the process will flow most effectively. The enlistment and training of participants will begin. Information about the campaign will be shared. And as the campaign comes alive, we'll experience an "aha" moment. We'll get it! And in so doing we'll move from "I Wish" to "I See".

Above all else, we want to remember this. *For Generations to Come* is a spiritual process. Of course, we are attempting to raise money. But more importantly, we celebrate the fact that God raises people!
