Welcome to the 2017-2018 Awana Club Year!

You are in a unique Awana Club! Do you now how many clubs have K-12 clubs available in a 20 mile radius of Warrenton? Two! WBF 7309 has a long history of maintaining a strong JV and Varsity AWANA program, which is rare! We aim to bring love and the gospel to every clubber that enters our doors, and equip every clubber to be a child of God ready to share the Gospel with anyone they meet, a potential Citation award recipient, and Scholarship applicant!

How do we do this? By being your partner in the Word of God! Awana is a tool that you, the parents use, to bring your child up in the training and admonition of the Lord. You help your child memorize the Word and complete the sections in their handbook. Most clubbers need to complete 2-3 sections in their handbook each week in order to complete the book by year's end and receive their award. **Encourage your clubber to complete tasks in their hand book and work on memorization daily. Add Awana to their daily homework assignments and this will become a natural daily habit of being in God's Word!** Additionally, JV and Varsity clubbers are required to read and summarize books of the Bible on a predetermined schedule. Varsity clubbers are also required to have service hours and an annual conference.
