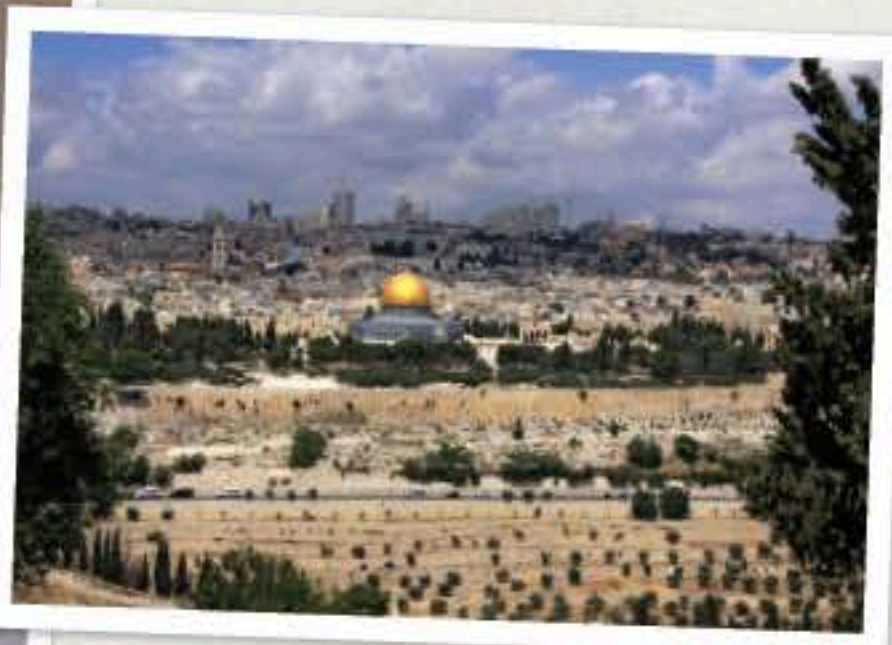

**DAY 1 | SUNDAY, MAY 13 | DESTINATION ISRAEL**

Meet at the EL AL check in counter, LAX International Airport at 10:15am. Depart at 1:15pm on a direct flight to Tel Aviv. Meals served on board.

**DAY 2 | MONDAY, MAY 14 | TEL AVIV & JERUSALEM**

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 1:45p and meet your tour guide. Head south to Jerusalem. Stop at Nebi Samuel, the suggested burial place of Samuel the prophet. Visit the intriguing site and enjoy your first view of Jerusalem from the roof top. (Dinner)  
4 nights Har Zion, Jerusalem

**DAY 3 | TUESDAY, MAY 15 | BIBLICAL JERUSALEM**

Begin the day at the pools of Bethsaida and St. Anne's church where Jesus healed the paralytic man. View the Old and New City from the Mt. of Olives. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus and the Galileans walking down the hillside on the route of Palm Sunday via Dominus Flevit with time for worship and prayer in the olive orchard. Continue to David's City visiting Warren's shaft, Hezekiah's or the Canaanite Tunnel and the Pools of Siloam. Enter the Old City through the Dung gate. Visit the Western Wall (Kotel), and then walk back in time through the Western Wall Tunnel Excavations. (Breakfast & dinner)

**DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, MAY 16 | ANCIENT JERUSALEM**

Visit Yad Vashem, national memorial and Museum of the Shoah. Pay tribute to the six million victims of the Holocaust in Europe during the Second World War. Travel back to Old City and stroll through the colorful Suk (market place), stopping to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Continue through the Suk (market place) in the Old City in route to the Jewish quarter. View some of the archaeological windows into the past from the first and second temple periods in the Roman/Byzantine/Crusader Street called the "Cardo." Visit the Southern Wall Archaeological Park to see the impressive excavations along the South Western Wall of the Temple Mount and to stand on the very same ancient steps that Jesus and the disciples used 2,000 years ago to enter the House of God. Stop at the Garden Tomb to remember the resurrection and worship with Holy Communion. (Breakfast & dinner)

**DAY 5 | THURSDAY MAY 17 | JERUSALEM**

Spend a day at leisure in this fascinating city. Return to places of interest; visit one of the many Museums in the city (modest fee required), shop in the Old or the New City, or dabble in archaeology at Emek Zurim, a salvage dig in Jerusalem where you can "dig up your past." (Breakfast & dinner)

**DAY 6 | FRIDAY MAY 18 | JORDAN**

Get an early start and travel through the Judean desert to the Allenby Bridge and cross into Jordan. The route will take you through the mountains of Moab of Ruth and Naomi fame. Emulating the children of Israel and Moses, stop on Mt. Nebo for a glimpse of the Promised Land. Continue along the Kings way to visit the desert fortress of Mukwir (Machaerus) where Herod Antipas held as prisoner and then killed, John the Baptist. Continue south to Petra.  
1 night Petra Palace, Petra (Breakfast & dinner)

OR

**DAY 7 | SATURDAY, MAY 19 | PETRA—ONE OF THE SEVEN WONDERS OF THE WORLD**

Get an early start, walking and riding into the center of the ancient Nabatean capital, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. See the stunning charm of the Necropolis and magnificent multi-colored sandstone. In the mid-afternoon leave Petra, traveling south on the Kings Way. Then follow in the footsteps of Joshua and the children of Israel, cross into Israel (at the Arava terminal) and travel through the Arava wilderness to the Dead Sea.  
1 night David Hotel & Spa, Dead Sea (Breakfast & dinner)

**DAY 8 | SUNDAY, MAY 20 | THE BOTTOM OF THE WORLD & GALILEE**

Begin the morning at the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth (417 meter below sea level). Enjoy a unique experience, "floating" in the Dead Sea. You cannot sink! Stop at the Southern Altar with time for worship and prayer. Visit Masada, ruins of King Herod's mountaintop fortress, which later became the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against Rome 73 C.E. (Ascend and descend by cable car). View the oasis at Ein Gedi where we remember David fleeing the wrath of King Saul. Visit Qumran where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered in a nearby cave, site of the "Cult of the Judean Desert." Following the route of the Galilean pilgrims ascend through the Judean Desert and along the Jordan River to the Galilee. End the day at Yardenit for a baptism ceremony.  
2 nights Ramot Hotel, Golan Heights (Breakfast & dinner)

**DAY 9 | MONDAY, MAY 21 | GALILEE**

Visit sites central to Jesus' Ministry beginning at the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the famous "Sermon on the Mount" (Matt. 5); then to the Church of the Primacy of Peter (Tabgha) on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Kfar Nahum Capernaum, center of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee and the site of many of His miracles (Mark 2:4; Matt. 8:5; 9). See the remains of St. Peter's mother-in-law's home and the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mark 1:21; Luke 4:31). Enjoy a fish lunch on the "other side." Following the tradition of the "fishermen" disciples, sail on the Sea of Galilee with time for worship and prayer. View the famous ancient boat from the time of Jesus. Travel North to Banias to visit Caesarea Philippi, the Northern extent of Jesus' Ministry, where Jesus asked, "Who do men say I am?" (Breakfast, lunch & dinner)

**DAY 10 | TUESDAY, MAY 22 | GALILEE & TEL AVIV**

Travel through the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's fortified city kingdoms (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), where the book of Revelation will come to life at the site of the epic Armageddon, with impressive ruins of 21 layers of destruction. Continue to Muhraka, (the burned spot), on the summit of Mt. Carmel where Elijah challenged the false prophets of Baal. Stop at Caesarea, the Roman capital and the largest port in the Mediterranean built by King Herod The Great. Here Pontius Pilate had his seat, Cornelius

lived and was baptized (Acts 10), Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30), and Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City. Then travel south through the Plain of Sharon, along the Mediterranean shore on the old coastal road known in Roman times as the Via Maris, which linked Egypt and Babylon to Tel Aviv. Check into Herod's Hotel, Tel Aviv. Enjoy a farewell dinner in the hotel. Meet for debriefing. Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your flight to LA.
