2. If you did not know anything about Paul, what can learn about him by reading verses 3 – 5?

3. Why is it important for Paul to share the earlier part of his life when he was hostile against Christianity?

4. What new facts are presented by Paul in this account of his conversion? (Compare to Acts 9:3 – 9)

5. What do you know about this Ananias after reading verses 12 – 16? (This is not the high priest Ananias.)

6. There are 5 things that God called Paul to do. What are they as identified in verses 14 – 16?

7. Paul had a vision and received clear instructions from God. What were these instructions?
