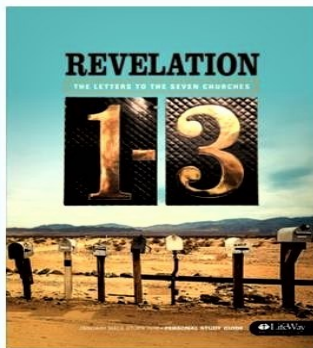


## Sunday Evening Bible Studies

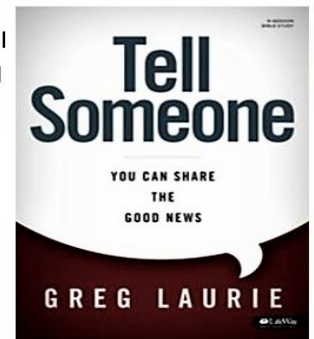

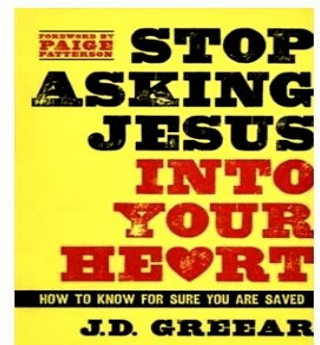
This study by Greg Laurie will help you identify people and places already in your daily routine, encouraging and empowering you to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Led by Bryan Hawkins.

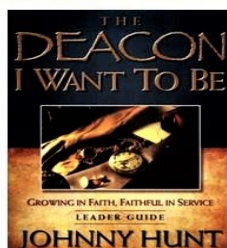
### Study for Students:
