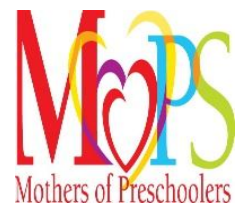
We will celebrate the Sacrament of Communion on Sunday, August 5th at both the 8:00 a.m. and the 10:45 a.m. services.
