

Zion Awana Adopt-a-Club

Awana clubs are located in over 110 countries. Kids around the world need our help. Kids in other countries have a lot in common with you. They go to school, attend church, visit relatives, laugh, play and explore the world around them.

In other ways, their lives may be very different from yours. Some children work long hours in the fields so their families have food to eat. Many have never seen TV or a computer or played video games. But with your help, they can study God's Word and learn about Jesus Christ through your Awana.

Kids around the world meet each week in Awana clubs much like yours. They wear uniforms, learn Bible verses, play games and complete handbooks. For many of them, this is possible only as children like you give money through the Adopt-a-Club program. The past couple of years our Awana club has been supporting a club in Paraguay. Last year the clubbers at Zion raised around \$1200.00 that was sent to our sister Awana club. Starting next week, January 21st we will begin raising money. You may bring donations at any time and drop it off in your club's jar up through March 25th. During the month of February we will have a Verse-a-thon where you go to relatives, friends and neighbors and get them to pledge a donation for each verse you say during February. At the end you will collect the pledges, tally your totals and possibly win a prize for bringing in the most money!

For the next few weeks try to come up with some ways that you can earn money to send to Awana children in Paraguay. Maybe ask mom and dad if you can have the change in their pockets at the end of the day, put it in a baggy and bring it to Awana each week. Instead of eating that ice cream cone ask mom or dad for the money and drop it in your club's donation jar the next time you are at Awana.
