Zion's Awana Grand Prix Entrance Guidelines and Regulations

*Each year a new car kit must be registered for the Awana Grand Prix.

*A number is assigned to the vehicle owner at the time of registration and their number **must be** on the vehicle upon entry.

*The finished vehicle size must not exceed:

7 inches long

2 ¾ inches wide including wheels

3 inches high sitting on its wheels

Weigh over 5 ounces

(At check in the car must fit down in Zion's regulation Grand Prix box and be officially weighed in.)

*Only **Awana** wheels and axles are acceptable.

***Awana** wheels may be "trued" and axles may be polished.

Weights are permissible, if used on the underbelly of the car the must be thin and flat so as not to interfere with the car successfully running on the track.

*Clubbers can add additional decals, steering wheels, drivers, windshields, trim or anything else as long as the car does not exceed size and weight requirements. (Cars can have removable parts that are used only during the Design competition and removed for the race. These parts are not included in the check in procedure of measuring and weighing.)

*All entrants must have participated in the design and/or building of their car. The car should not be totally designed and built by an adult.

*Clubbers wishing to enter their finished vehicle in either the Vehicle Design or Creative Design Competition must have played an **active role** in the completion of their car. (It should be obvious to the judges that the clubber participated in the finished product.)

*Finished vehicles must be turned in by the deadline in order to qualify for the race and design judging.
