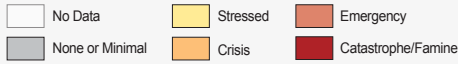


## ESTIMATED FOOD SECURITY LEVELS THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2017\*

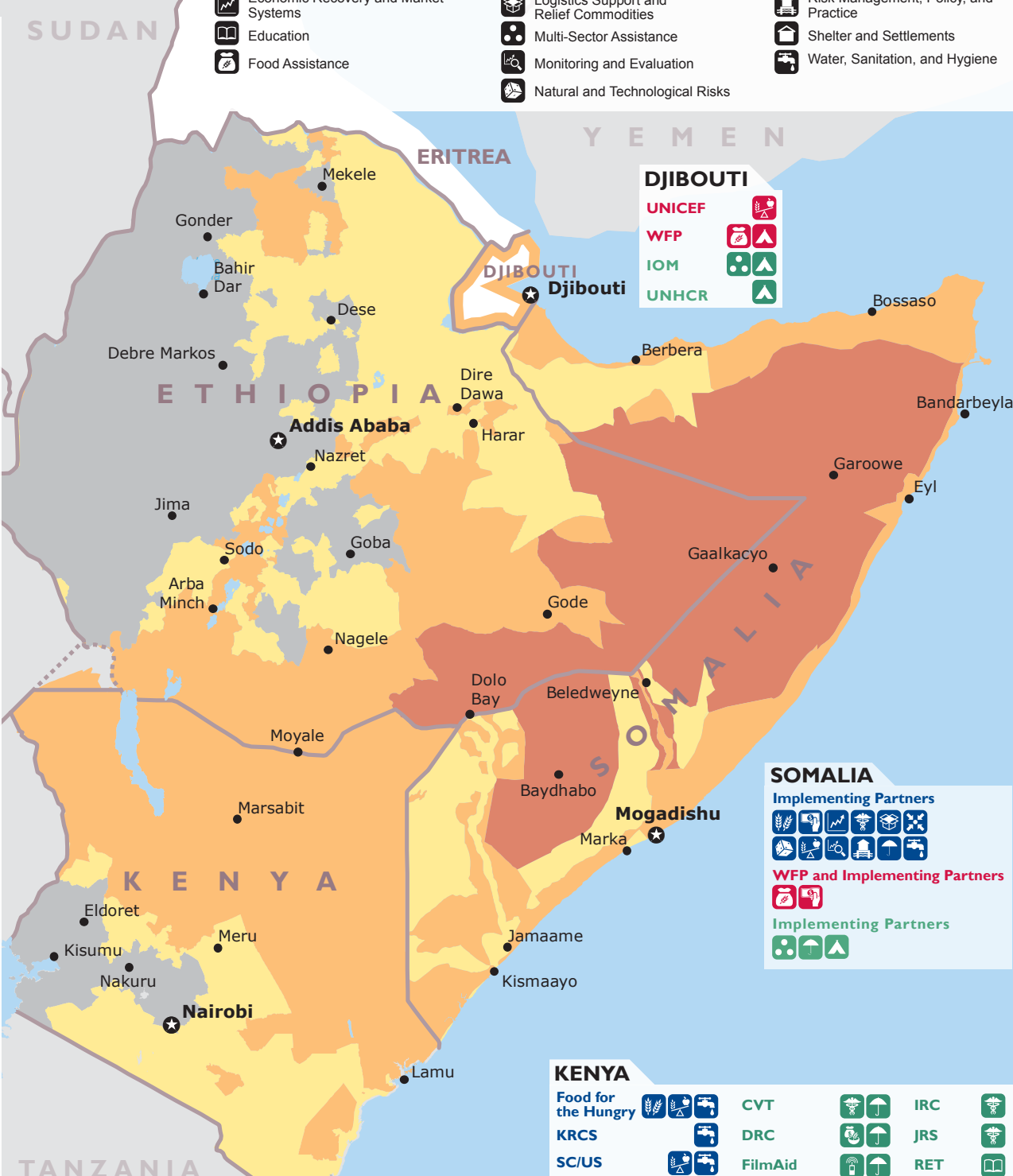
