

RESOLUTION NO. 498 CMS

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER
OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO
TO FILE AN APPEAL UNDER OHIO REVISED CODE
5705.37 AND DECLARE IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to action by the Budget Commission of Lorain County, Ohio, a Certificate of Allocation of the estimated revenues derived from sales tax and bank deposit taxes of the local government fund was issued the 13th day of March, 1963, and received by the fiscal officer of the City of Oberlin on the 14th day of March, 1963, and

WHEREAS, the taxing authority of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, to-wit: the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, is dissatisfied with the action of the Budget Commission in the allocation of estimated revenue as set forth in said Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the fiscal officer of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, to-wit, the City Auditor, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file an appeal under Ohio Revised Code 5705.37 to appeal the action of the Budget Commission of Lorain County, Ohio, and the Certificate of Allocation dated March 13, 1963 of the estimated revenues of sales tax and bank deposit taxes issued thereunder.

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and further necessary for the reason that Ohio Revised Code 5705.37 limits the time within which an appeal may be filed, namely, within 30 days, and said resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
