

RESOLUTION NO. 103 CMS

APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY PLANS AND ARCHITECTURAL DESIGNS OF THE LORAIN METROPOLITAN HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR PUBLIC HOUSING IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN AS PREPARED BY MEATHE-KESSLER, ARCHITECTS, AND DECLARING SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, certain preliminary plans and architectural designs of the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority as prepared by Meathe-Kessler, Architects for public housing in the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin desires to approve same.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the city of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the preliminary plans and architectural designs of the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, as prepared by Meathe-Kessler, architects for public housing in the city of Oberlin are approved.

Section 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite public housing in the City of Oberlin, Ohio and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
