

RESOLUTION NO. 517 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF
ORDINARY EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN
UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS
MEASURE SHALL BE PASSED AND TO DECLARE SAME
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the official certificate of estimated resources
has not been received from the County Budget Commission, and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds on hand to operate
until such time as the official certificate is received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the
City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That the City Auditor be authorized to pay
all legal bills of the City.

SECTION 2: That any payment above authorized shall be
chargeable to the appropriations in the annual appropriation measure
when passed.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation
of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin,
Ohio, to-wit: To expedite payment of the Ordinary Expenses of the
City of Oberlin, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
