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RESOLUTION NO. 519 CMS STATING A
"DECLARATION OF POLICY" AND REQUEST-
ING IHFA ASSISTANCE - EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin recognizes that substandard environmental conditions exist in certain areas and neighborhoods of the city, and
- WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin also recognizes that unless these conditions are corrected, the full amenities of community living cannot be realized, and
- WHEREAS, the solution is a many-faceted one involving improved housing, traffic circulation, public improvements, parks, play grounds, and recreation facilities, and
- WHEREAS, the facilities and resources of the local government are not extensive and adequate enough to correct the condition, and
- WHEREAS, the facilities and resources available to private enterprise are not sufficient to cope with the full problem.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The City of Oberlin has completed its report of progress under the Workable Program for community improvement and for the elimination and prevention of slums and blight and submits the same herewith.

SECTION 2. The City of Oberlin seeks the assistance of the Housing and Home Finance Agency of the U. S. Government in lending their guidance, experience, and resources in identifying the proper remedy, and introducing the proper Program for solution, whether it be one of "Conservation", "Rehabilitation", or "Redevelopment".

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit: To expedite the construction of low cost public housing and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
