

RESOLUTION NO. 530 CMS

NAMING THE LOCAL PUBLIC HOUSING PROJECTS

EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the City of Oberlin is participating in Local Public Housing,
and

WHEREAS the Housing Renewal Commission has unanimously selected
the name of "THE JOHN FREDERICK OBERLIN HOMES" as its choice in
honor of the person, John Frederick Oberlin, for whom Oberlin
College and the Community was named.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of
Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths)
of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Public Housing Projects now
being constructed in the City of Oberlin, Ohio be
named "The John Frederick Oberlin Homes".

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the
safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin,
to-wit: To identify the low cost public housing. It shall take
effect immediately upon passage.
