WHEREAS, A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS, TO TRANSFER USE AND CONTROL OVER A CERTAIN HIGHWAY ROADSIDE PARK LOCATED ON STATE HIGHWAY 10 TOGETHER WITH ALL APPURTENANCES THEREON, TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF OBERLIN

Known as East Area No. 541

WHEREAS, in connection with the improvement of State Highway No. 10, Lorain County, Ohio, it was desirable and necessary for the public convenience and welfare to alter and realign said highway.

WHEREAS, on March 11, 1939, the State of Ohio acquired a perpetual easement for highway purposes which is recorded in Volume 257, Pages 117, in the Records of Deeds, Lorain County, Ohio, and referred to as Parcel No. 1 R.P. and

WHEREAS, this Council, on behalf of all the inhabitants of the Municipality of Oberlin, desires to urge the State of Ohio and Department of Highways, to retain such premises for long accustomed public park usage under municipal direction and maintenance and to leave all appurtenances now thereupon for such purposes,

AND, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Municipality of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio.

Section 1. That this Council hereby expresses the desire of all the inhabitants of the Municipality of Oberlin and urges the State of Ohio and Department of Highways to do all things within their power necessary to transfer the use and control of said highway roadside park located adjacent to State Route 10 unto the Municipality of Oberlin to be operated and maintained hereafter as a municipal park and recreation area including as a part thereof all appurtenances now located thereupon including a shelter house, toilet facilities, picnic tables, and a well.

Section 2. The municipality hereby agrees to be responsible for the maintenance and operation of said park from and after the effective date of such transfer.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this Council is hereby authorized and directed to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Highways, Division 3, Columbus, Ohio, and to F. E. Bachelder, Director, State of Ohio, Department of Highways.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
