RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF SOUTH MAIN STREET, HAMILTON STREET (WEST), LINCOLN STREET, AND EASEMENTS OF LIFT LINE BETWEEN SAIDLY TERMINI BY CONSTRUCTING SANITARY SEWERS, SANITARY SEWER CURB CONNECTIONS, A LIFT STATION AND ALL NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THEREON, AND REGARDING AN EMERGENCY

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio:

Section 1. That Anton Bellovek, Lee Holden and Paul Stone, three disinterested freeholders of said City be and they are hereby appointed to act as an assessment equalization board to hear and determine all timely written objections to the estimated assessments heretofore reported to this Council of the cost of improving South Main Street from Lincoln Street to Hamilton Street, Hamilton Street (West) from South Main Street westerly a distance of approximately 3,207 feet, Lincoln Street from a point approximately 105 feet westerly of the center line of Hamilton Street (West) northerly approximately 397 feet to an angle to Lincoln Street and then northeasterly approximately 9 1/2 feet to a point, and easements of the City of Oberlin through the easterly 10 feet of lands now or formerly owned by Clark Brothers, Inc. (Trp. Lot 94, Sublot A), by Citizens Home & Savings Association (Trp. Lot 54, Sublot 4) and by Thomas and Jennie Parker (Trp. Lot 54, Sublot 4) said easements extending from a point in Hamilton Street (West) approximately 3,207 feet westerly of South Main Street and approximately 17 feet easterly of the easterly line of Lincoln Street northerly to Lincoln Street, the construction of sanitary sewers, sanitary sewer curb connections, a lift station at South Main Street and Lincoln Street and all necessary appurtenances thereon and to equalize the same as to them seems proper, in accordance with law and all resolutions heretofore adopted by this Council on September 20, 1965.

Section 2. The board shall first meet for the above purpose at the City Hall at 7:30 P.M. EST on the 25th day of October, 1965, and at the completion of such equalization shall report such equalized assessments to Council.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to protect the health of the property owners to be assessed and the inhabitants of the City; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
