

RESOLUTION NO. 548 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY OFFICE FOR PROGRAM ENRICHMENT FOR THE SUMMER OF 1966.

WHEREAS, there is at present a School Community Office for Program Enrichment being considered for the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin deems it for the best interests of the health, welfare, and future of the City of Oberlin and its residents to participate in said program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Oberlin recognizes the need of said program on a City-wide basis and the program as presented would be of substantial benefit to the citizens of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. The City of Oberlin through its administrative officers participate in said program, namely, the School Community Office for Program Enrichment commonly called SCOPE, through the Lorain County Office of Economic Opportunity Committee.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby appropriated and made available for said program, the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) and the City Manager is hereby authorized to furnish said Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) or services and materials in kind for programs approved by him such as:

- (a) Plum Creek cleaning and beautification
- (b) Comprehensive sanitary sewer cross connection survey.

and or other programs which will benefit the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, to-wit:

To accomplish certain physical improvements and plans for the future and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


