

RESOLUTION NO. 554 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF LINCOLN STREET BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI BY GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING AND PAVING, CONSTRUCTING STORM SEWERS, STORM SEWER CURB CONNECTIONS, TOGETHER WITH ALL NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Robert R. Williams, 302 N. Prospect Street, George T. Jones, 322 W. College Street, and Burrell Scott, 279 N. Pleasant Street, three disinterested freeholders of said City be and they are hereby appointed to act as an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all timely written objections to the estimated assessments heretofore reported to this Council of the cost of improving Lincoln Street from South Professor Street westerly and thence southerly to West Hamilton Street by grading, draining, curbing and paving, constructing storm sewers, storm sewer curb connections, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto and to equalize the same as to them seems proper, in accordance with law and with Resolution No. 552 CMS adopted by this Council on June 6, 1966.

SECTION 2. The Board shall first meet for the above purpose at the Oberlin City Hall, 69 South Main Street, Oberlin, Ohio at 8:00 P.M., EDT, on the 27th day of July, 1966, and upon the completion of such equalization shall report such equalized assessment to Council.

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrians and vehicular traffic; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
