

RESOLUTION NO. 555 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REPORT OF THE ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD ON OBJECTIONS CONCERNING THE ESTIMATED ASSESSMENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF LINCOLN STREET BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, BY GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING AND PAVING, CONSTRUCTING STORM SEWERS, STORM SEWER CURB CONNECTIONS, TOGETHER WITH ALL NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Assessment Equalization Board heretofore appointed by Resolution No. 554 CMS, passed July 18, 1966, to hear and determine all objections concerning the estimated assessments for the improvement of Lincoln Street from South Professor Street westerly and thence southerly to West Hamilton Street by grading, draining, curbing and paving, constructing storm sewers, storm sewer curb connections, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto, in accordance with Resolution No. 552 CMS, passed June 6, 1966, has filed its report with this Council as to its determination of such objections; and

WHEREAS, Council deems such report proper in all respects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the report of the Assessment Equalization Board hereinbefore recited be and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the difference between the aggregate amount of the estimated assessments and the aggregate amount of the estimated assessments adjusted by said Board in order to equalize said assessments results in an aggregate reduction of \$1,267.50 which should be assumed by the City and said amount of \$1,267.50 or the proportionate increase or decrease of said amount based on the final cost of the improvement is hereby assumed by the city.

SECTION 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian and vehicular traffic; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
