

RESOLUTION NO. 556 CMS

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE OBERLIN COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION AS THE AGENT FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN.

WHEREAS, there has been recently formed The Oberlin Community Improvement Corporation as a non-profit corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, said Corporation being organized pursuant to Chapter 1724 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the promotion of industrial, commercial and research development in the City of Oberlin is beneficial to the inhabitants of said City, and

SECTION 2. That the policy of the City of Oberlin is to promote the health, safety and general welfare of its inhabitants and to accomplish the purposes mentioned in Section 1 above through the designation of the Oberlin Community Improvement Corporation as an agency of the city.

SECTION 3. Oberlin Community Improvement Corporation is hereby designated as the official agency for the City of Oberlin as provided in Chapter 1724 of the Ohio Revised Code, and said agency is fully authorized to provide any or all of the services, facilities or action as set forth in Section 1724.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, under the conditions, limitations, etc., set forth in said Chapter 1724.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
