

RESOLUTION NO. 560 CMS

APPROVING THE WORKABLE PROGRAM SUBMITTED TO THE
CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, has previously employed the City Planning Associates, Inc. to prepare a workable program for the City of Oberlin as well as other allied papers for presentation to the Department of HUD (Housing & Urban Development), and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin recognizes an obligation to the general welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to eliminate and prevent slums and blight in all areas of the community through the use of public and private resources, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Oberlin to develop and administer a workable program for community improvement by use of all available resources, both public and private.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the Workable Program as submitted by City Planning Associates, Inc., be and the same is hereby approved, and said report authorized to be submitted to the Department of Housing & Urban Development.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To expedite the application to HUD for a rehabilitation and conservation project for an area south-east of the central business district, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


