

RESOLUTION NO. 570 CMS

APPROVING THE USE OF 85 SOUTH MAIN STREET
BY THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGE STORES
FOR WAREHOUSING PURPOSES AND DECLARING SAME
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, heretofore the National Association of College Stores has made application to use 85 South Main Street, Oberlin, Ohio for storage of paper back books for a period beginning March 6, 1967, and ending February 15, 1969.

WHEREAS, the Oberlin City Planning Commission recommended the use for such period.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed use of the National Association of College Stores of 85 South Main Street, Oberlin, Ohio, for storage of paper back books be and the same is hereby approved for a period commencing March 6, 1967 and ending February 15, 1969.

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


