RESOLUTION NO. 572 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF COUNCIL
TO ELIMINATE CERTAIN REAL ESTATE LEVIES AND
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a recreational levy in the amount of .47 mills is expiring
in December, 1967, and

WHEREAS, there is currently in effect a garbage levy in the amount
of 1.5 mills, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, has heretofore
passed an Income Tax Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
State of Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring


SECTION 1. That it is the intent of this Council
to eliminate the Recreation Levy and supply recreation funds from
the general fund and the Garbage Levy from the tax duplicate of the
City of Oberlin, Ohio, commencing with the year 1968, provided the
Income Tax for the City of Oberlin is in full force and effect for
the year 1968 and 1969.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, safety, and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, and
shall take effect on the date of passage.


