RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE EFFORT OF THE LORAIN PORT AUTHORITY TO LOCATE AN INTERNATIONAL TRADE CENTER FOR NORTH CENTRAL OHIO AT LORAIN, OHIO.

- WHEREAS, The City of Lorain has a port and a duly established Port Authority under state statute, and
- WHEREAS, There are, in the jurisdiction of the Lorain Port Authority, several sites which meet the criteria established by Governor Rhodes International Trade Center Committee, and,
- WHEREAS, The region of North Central Chio, as defined for the purposes of this center, includes Lorain County and the City of Lorain, and
- WHEREAS, The Board of Directors of Lorain Port Authority, believing the International Trade Center an asset to the North Central Ohio region, have submitted proposals to the International Trade Center Committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OBERLIE, OHIO, THAT:

- SECTION 1. This Council does commend and support the efforts of the Board of Director of Lorain Port Authority;
- SECTION II. The Clerk is instructed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Mr. A. David Baumbart, Chairman, Lorain Port Authority for his disposition.
