

RESOLUTION NO. 588 CMS

APPROVING THE WORKABLE PROGRAM SUBMITTED BY
THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin recognizes an obligation to the general welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to eliminate and prevent slums and blight in all areas of the community through the use of public and private resources, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Oberlin to develop and administer a Workable Program for community improvement by use of all available resources, both public and private.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Workable Program for 1968 be and the same is hereby approved, and said report authorized to be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

To submit same to the Federal Government within the deadline and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


