

RESOLUTION NO. 595 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE NORTHEAST STORM SEWER DISTRICT NO. 12.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That James Gilchrist, 891 Kimberly Circle; Howard O. Jones, 208 N. Main Street; and H. S. Arnold, Pyle-S. Amherst Road, three disinterested freeholders of said City of Oberlin, be and they hereby are appointed to act as an assessment equalization board to hear and determine all timely objections to the estimated assessments heretofore reported to this Council as the cost for improving the Northeast Storm Sewer District No. 12 of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, North Pleasant Street from a point approximately 330 feet North of the center line of Walnut Street Northerly to Maple Street, Maple Street from North Pleasant Street to North Main Street, and an easement of the City from a point approximately 1,393 feet North of Walnut Street Easterly a distance of approximately 1,069 feet to an open watercourse by constructing a storm sewer and necessary appurtenances thereto, and easements of the City following the course of such watercourse from the Easterly terminus of such storm sewer in the aforesaid easement Easterly a distance of approximately 3,850 feet to Oberlin Avenue by changing the channel of, dredging, deepening and otherwise improving such watercourse, and to equalize the same as to them seems proper, in accordance with law, and with Resolution No. 590 CMS, adopted by this Council on May 20, 1968.

SECTION 2. The Board shall first meet for the above purpose at Council Chambers, City Hall, Oberlin, Ohio, on the 25th day of July, 1968, at 7:30 P. M., and upon completion of such equalization, shall report such equalized assessments to Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.


